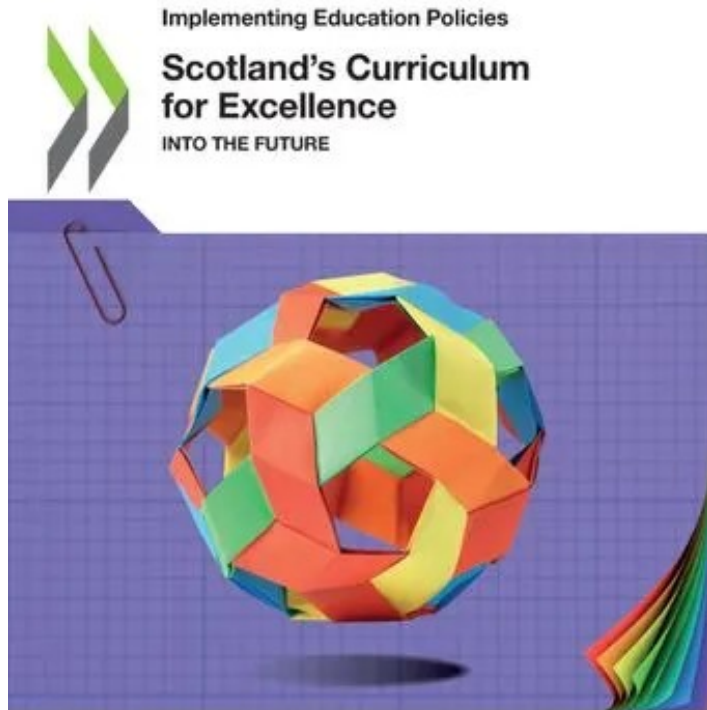

- We need to keep the momentum going, it's the perfect time to work on strengthening our policy

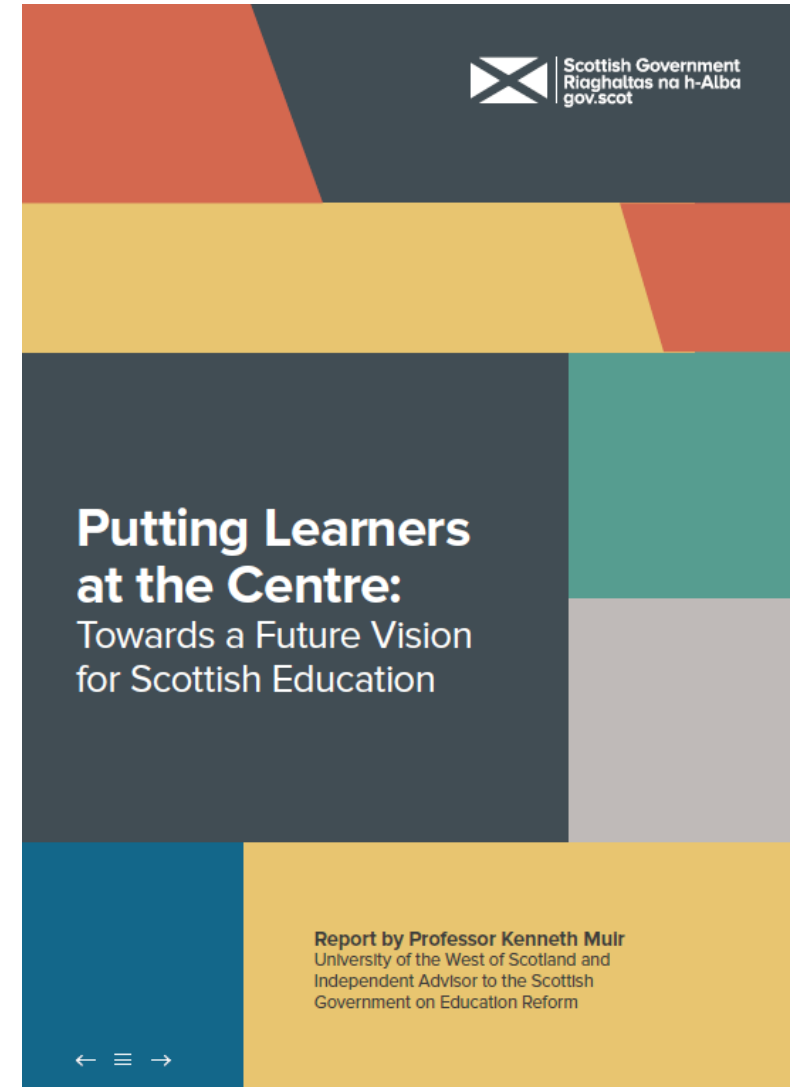


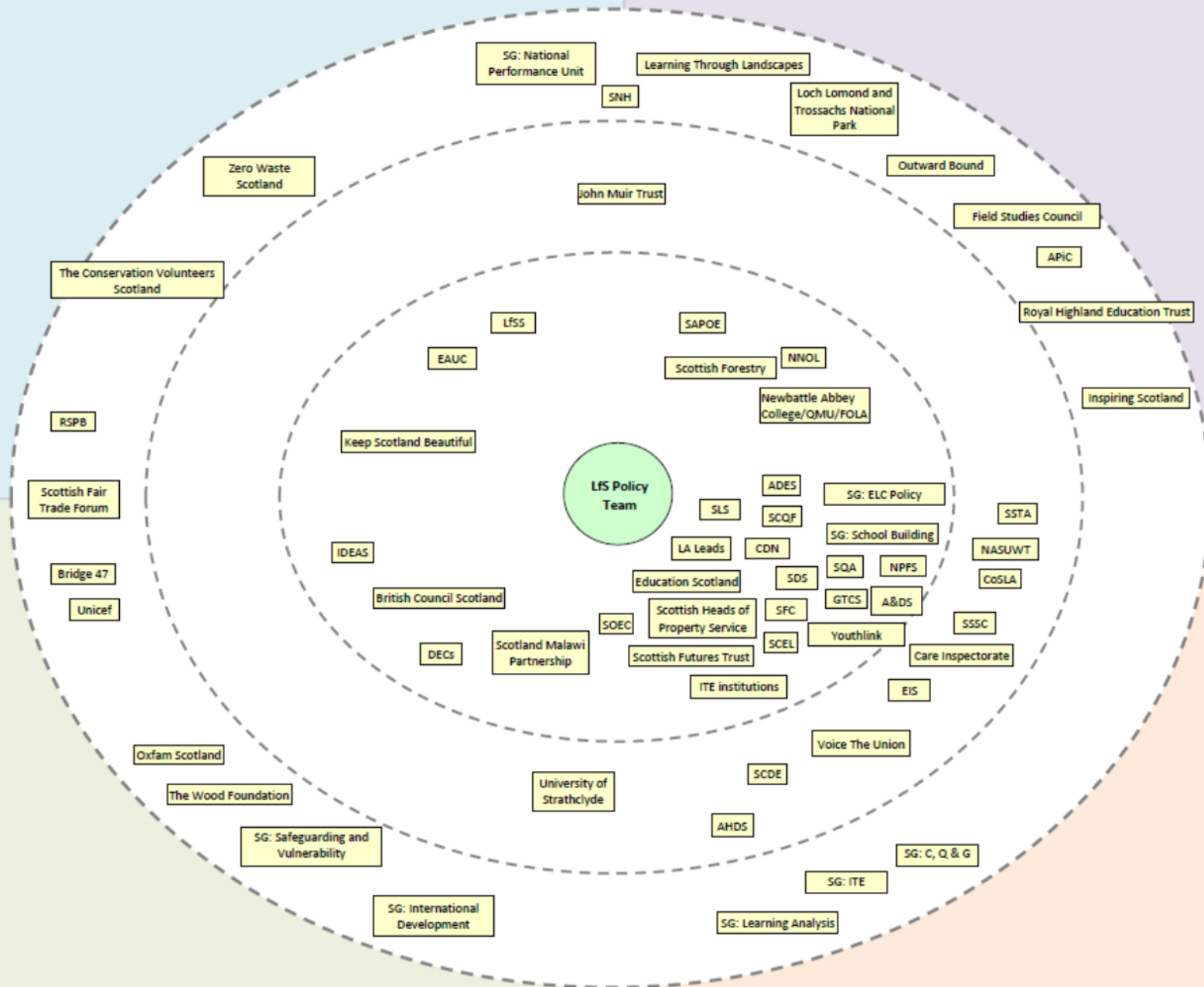
