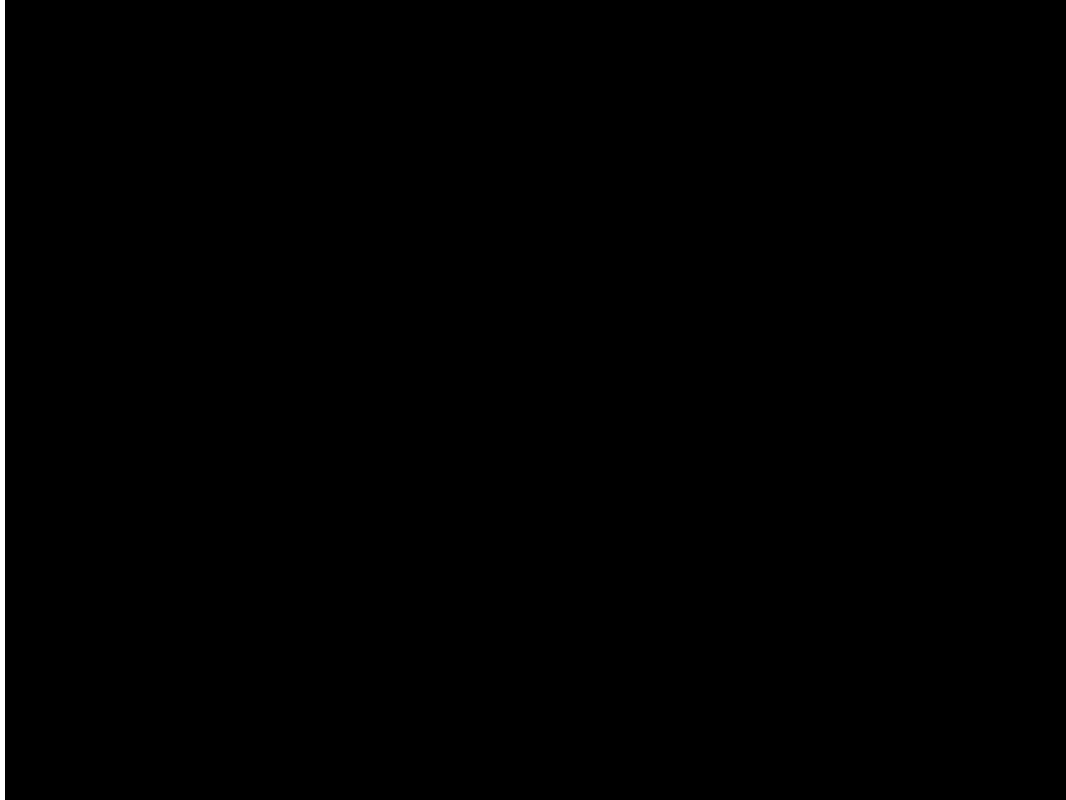

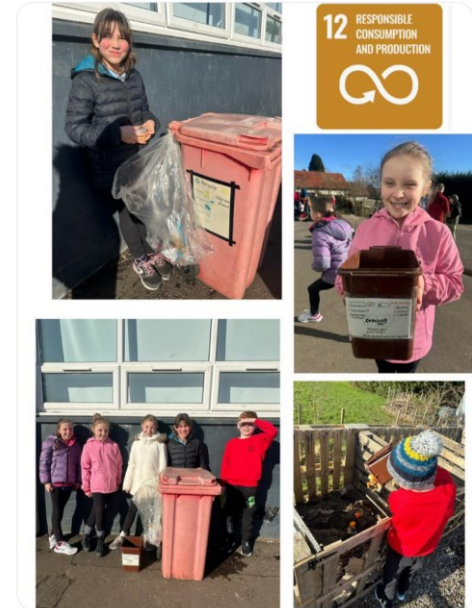
Developing LfS across our *Campus*

- Pre- loved uniform rail and pre loved books etc



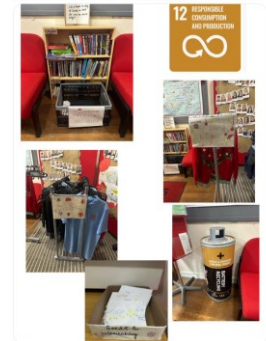
